At the May 17, 2022 City Council Special Meeting, votes from the May 7, 2022 General Election were canvassed and the results were declared valid. Mayor **Kevin Raines**, Councilor At-Large Position 1 **Marc A. Morales**, Councilor At-Large Position 2 **Alicia Casias**, Councilor District 1 **Keith Parker**, Councilor District 2 **Susan Euton** and Councilor District 4 **George A. Zepeda, Sr.** were then sworn in for their two-year term. A runoff election is scheduled for June 11, 2022, for the position of Councilor District 3 between candidates Hector Trevino and Randy Weishiemer.
