The Rosenberg Civic Center boasts over 16,000 square feet of space for corporate and social functions. The versatile center can be used for public and private events such as meetings, weddings, showers, parties, classes and more!

Did you know that the Center also hosts a variety of leisure classes and recreational opportunities? Take a look below at the many current offerings! There's something for everyone!

Are you interested in holding classes in Rosenberg? The Civic Center is always looking for instructors to expand our Leisure Activities! We'd love to hear from you.

- **American Association of Retired Persons (AARP):** AARP hosts a monthly gathering that includes lunch, a chapter meeting, entertainment and games. The class is free to attend for AARP Members.
- **Ballet Classes:** The City has partnered with Epic Center of Dance to offer classes in Ballet, Tap and Jazz! Classes are held on Monday and Tuesday evenings and open to children ages 2 through 13. Prices range from \$35 to \$55 per month.
- **Crafting Group:** Enjoy crafting? Join us as we get together on the first Tuesday of the month to craft! Bring your own supplies, start a new project or finish that project you are working on while we fellowship. This class is free to attend!
- **The Golden Years – Senior Group:** The Golden Years is a senior-centered organization that provides and coordinates leisure activities for our senior citizens. Activities range from crafts, bingo, crossword puzzles, health information, plus valuable life skills such as learning social media, banking, etc. Classes are \$10 per class or \$30 per month and are open to those ages 55 and up.
- **Sewing Group:** Join the Rose–Rich Sew-N-Sews, a group of sewing enthusiast citizens, on the 2nd Friday of the month to learn new sewing skills, network with others who share an interest in sewing and participate in community service sewing projects! The class is free to attend with an American Sewing Guild Membership.
- **Zumba:** The Civic Center is hopping on Monday and Wednesday evenings to Zumba! This fun interval-style dance fitness class combines low-intensity and high-intensity moves creating a dynamic calorie-burning form of workout for people of all fitness levels and age groups. The cost is \$5 per class and classes start at 7 p.m.
- **Yoga:** Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings are geared towards a mind, body and breath connection with our all-level vinyasa class. Drop in for \$12 per class, or take 4 classes per month for \$40 or 8 classes per month for \$75.
