## COUNCIL CORNER

- City Council formally adopted the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget at the Sept. 3 Council Meeting. Read more about the budget at [rosenbergtx.gov/budget](http://rosenbergtx.gov/budget)
- City Council voted to cancel the November 26 & December 24 Council Workshop Meetings due to conflicts with City observed holiday closures.
- City Council formally approved the final plat for the future home of Lamar CISD's new Dr. Thomas E. Randle High School & Harry Wright Junior High School Campus to be located off FM-2977 near the intersection of Koeblen Road.
- Ordinance No. 2019-52 was passed amending the permissible sound levels. Daytime hours are now defined as 7:01 a.m.-10:00 p.m. & nighttime hours are now 10:01 p.m.-7:00 a.m. The maximum permissible sound level for non-residential properties is now 68 db(A) during the day and 58 db(A) during the night.

Recognizing the contributions that municipal court makes to the safety & well-being of our community.

Every November the City recognizes our Municipal Court Team made up of municipal judges, court clerks, court administrator, prosecutor & bailiff for the important role they play in our community. It's not an easy job & you may not get to meet them on your best day, but the City is thankful for our hard working staff & appreciate the job they do. A citation can be scary, but it doesn't have to be. We're here to help!

Here's a few helpful tips on what you can expect when you visit Rosenberg's Municipal Court.

### YOU'VE RECEIVED A CITATION – WHAT DO YOU DO NOW?

- PLAN AHEAD** Make arrangements to attend court on your specific court date. The Court is located at City Hall: 2110 4th St., Rosenberg, Texas 77471
- WHAT TO BRING** Driver's License or ID; Current Insurance; Insurance information from the time when the ticket was received.
- WHAT TO WEAR** **NO** torn or dirty clothes, shorts, hats, flip-flops, sunglasses, low-cut shirts, pajamas or clothes with obscene graphics or language. Business casual attire is appreciated.
- ETIQUETTE** Arrive on time; Turn off electronic devices including cell phones before entering the courtroom; Be polite to the Judge, Counsel & Staff; Rise when the Judge enters & leaves the courtroom; Do not interrupt others while they are speaking; Refer to the Judge as "Your Honor"; Direct all concerns & remarks to the Judge (and not opposing counsel).
